Year 3: 97.84%


Year 4: 94.09%

3 - Year 1 - Important Information

Year 1 Useful Dates and Information

The Year 1 team would like to provide you with some useful dates and information regarding reading books, homework and PE.

Reading Books

All children in Year 1 will have their reading books issued on the Collins eBooks platform. New books are assigned on a Friday, and the children will have read this book in class. Please hear your child read at home regularly and make a short comment in their Reading Record on the right side.

Little Wandle revised Letters and Sounds – Daily Phonics

All children continue to receive daily phonics. Each week staff will assign phonics homework to children using Microsoft Teams. The login information for this can be found in their Reading Record.

Homework

We will continue to use 'Teams' to send homework. Log in details can be found on the inside of your child's reading record. Once you have logged in, you will have access to your child's home learning.

PE Lessons

We would also like to inform you of the PE days for Year 1.

- Red 1's PE day is Friday.
- Yellow 1's PE day is Thursday.
- Blue 1's PE days is Wednesday.

No earrings to be worn on these days please, unless your child can take them out themselves.

Forest School will be weekly on a Tuesday and children will need to come to school wearing their school uniform and bring in their Forest School clothes. The children will need wellies, a waterproof coat, long sleeved top and long trousers. It might be helpful to send in spare socks. The children will need more layers when the weather starts to get colder.

4 - Year 2 - Important Information

We hope your child has enjoyed their start to Year 2. Please find below some important information you will find useful.

P.E Days

On your child's P.E. days, please can you ensure children have P.E. kits in school and long hair is tied back. Please note we are unable to help children take earrings out. Therefore, if your child cannot take their earrings out themselves, please remove them before school for them on P.E. days.

P.E. days are as follows:

Red 2 – Tuesday and Thursday

Yellow 2 – Monday and Thursday

Blue 2 – Monday and Wednesday

Reading

Over the next few weeks, most children will be completing the Little Wandle reading programme of books. They will then begin to bring a physical book home from the Collins scheme. New books will be given on a Friday and need to be returned by Wednesday. Children will also have access to books from class libraries which they will pick independently to read for pleasure either individually or to share with an adult at home.

Homework

Interactive tasks will be set on Microsoft teams. Instructions for how to access these can be found in your child's planner. Homework will be set on a Thursday and needs to be handed in by Wednesday. As well as this, please practise spellings.



5 - Year 3 - Important Information

We hope your child has enjoyed their start to Year 3. Please find below some important information you will find useful.

P.E Days

On your class PE days, please can you ensure children have PE kits in school. Your PE days are as follows:

Red 3 – Tuesday and Wednesday

Yellow 3- Tuesday and Wednesday

Blue 3 – Tuesday and Wednesday

If your child has any ear piercings, please can you ensure these are taken out and left at home on their PE days. Children are not allowed to cover ears with plasters, tape etc. Children should have a yellow t-shirt, red shorts and PE pumps.

Reading

New books will be given on a Friday and need to be returned by Wednesday. Children will also have access to books from class libraries which they will pick independently to read for pleasure either individually or to share with an adult at home.

Snacks

Children are allowed to bring a healthy snack in from home for morning playtimes.

Homework

Interactive tasks will be set on Microsoft teams. Instructions for how to access these can be found in your child's planner. Homework will be set on a Thursday and needs to be handed in by Wednesday. As well as this, please practise spellings and times tables.

6 - Year 4 - Important Information

7 - Year 5 - Important Information

The Year 5 team would like to provide you with some useful dates and information regarding reading books, homework and PE.

Reading Books

Thursday: Reading books will be collected in and a new reading book will be allocated.

Please hear your child read at home 3 times a week and make a short comment in their Reading Record. Reading books and reading diaries will need to be in school everyday.

Homework

We will continue to use Teams to send Maths Homework each week. Your child should have log in details to access Teams on your devices at home. However, if you need support with this please speak to a member of staff. Log in details can be found on the inside of your child's Reading Record. Once you have logged in, you will have access to your child's home learning. Children will have a Maths Homework book to work in.

- Thursday: Maths Homework set.
- Tuesday: Homework returned.In addition to this, your child will receive the following each week in their small red and blue books:
- Friday: Spellings and times tables (tested the following Friday).

PE Lessons

We would also like to inform you of the PE days for Year 5. Please ensure that the correct PE kit is in school.

There will be swimming for all of Year 5 on Tuesdays.

- Red 5 indoor PE on a Thursday
- Blue 5 Indoor PE on a Wednesday,
- Yellow 5 indoor PE on a Friday.

No earrings to be worn on these days please, unless your child can take them out themselves.

8 - Year 6 - Important Information

Reading remains a priority in Year 6. In school your child will be taking part in Guided Reading, independent reading and reading as part of other curriculum areas at school.

Your child would benefit greatly from reading regularly at home. We expect your child to read at least 3 times a week and for an adult to sign the reading record.

Children progress much more rapidly if they read frequently. The children have individual reading books that should be in school every day and the choice of a library book.

Our class novel this term is "Wonder" by R.J. Palacio.

Each class has two timetabled PE lessons each week. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit in school: red sports shorts, yellow k-shirt and black pumps (plain black jogging or tracksuit bottoms and a jumper in winter months). All jewellery must be removed for PE.

Blue 6 - Indoor P.E. Thursday/Outdoor P.E. Tuesday

Yellow 6 - Indoor P.E. Monday/Outdoor P.E. Tuesday

National Standard Assessment Tests (SATs):

Children will be assessed against year group expectations as either working towards, working at or exceeding age related expectations.
