How to Access Microsoft Teams

Go to www.rmunify.com



Type in your child's school email address. This is their last name followed by the first initial of their first name plus

@roberts.dudley.sch.uk

e.g. Kylie Minogue would be minoguek@roberts.dudley.sch.uk

Add your child's password.

Please make sure you use the correct capital or lower case letters.

Follow any on screen prompts to stay signed in.


There is an option to download a Microsoft Teams app - you are welcome to do this. You may get an option to see a short tutorial about how Microsoft Teams works.


How to Access Microsoft Teams
